

### **1. Tinnahalla (IRE)**

Good international prospect who won his Barrier Trial on June 5th, at Naas.

### **2. Kingslayer (FR)**

Finished first in a Naas Barrier Trial on June 5th. French premium eligible.

### **3. War Tiger (USA)**

90-rated three-year-old son of War Front is a two time winner this year

Royal Ascot entry: King George V Stakes

### **4. On A Session (USA)**

Dual winner at 2 and victorious this month on his latest start at Listowel. Now rated 94.

Royal Ascot entry: Jersey Stakes

### **5. Daughter In Law (IRE)**

Hugely impressive when making all to win her Curragh maiden on Irish 2000 Guineas day.

Royal Ascot entry: Queen Mary Stakes

### **6. Oxted (GB)**

Looked a high-class international racing prospect when runner-up in a Newbury Listed.

Royal Ascot entry: Jersey Stakes

### **7. Just Sensual (SAF)**

Group 1 winner and Champion 3yo filly in South Africa, daughter of a Champion 2yo filly. In foal to Frankel

### **8. Real Appeal (GER)**

Two wins from two starts including the Listed Prix la Fleche at Maisons-Laffitte. By Sidestep, sire of the Golden Slipper winner Kiamichi

Royal Ascot entry: Norfolk Stakes

### **9. Building Bridges (GB)**

Stayed on well to win at Navan on June 1st and looks highly progressive over a distance

### **10. Mohican Heights (IRE)**

Well related son of Australia who lived up to his pedigree when winning a competitive maiden at Leopardstown.

Royal Ascot entry: Chesham Stakes

### **11. Murasaki (GB)**

Winning daughter of Dubawi and Ribblesdale winner Michita. In foal to Invincible Spirit

### **12. Brand New Day (IRE)**

A classy 2yo with two wins from two starts and a runner-up spot from her three starts.

Royal Ascot entry: Queen Mary Stakes

### **13. Ivatheengine (IRE)**

Runner-up on his debut to subsequent stakes winner Flippa The Strippa, before winning on his second start.

Royal Ascot entry: Windsor Castle Stakes

### **14. Sestilio Jet (FR)**

Most recently runner-up in a Group 2 at Chantilly following on from a Group 3 win over five furlongs at Longchamp.

### **15. Simsimah**

Half-sister to Investec Derby runner up Madhmoon, from the family of Awtaad. Filly foal at foot by Divine Prophet and in foal to Expert Eye

### **16. Forever In Dreams (IRE)**

A well-related filly whose third and most recent success was in a Listed race at Haydock.

Royal Ascot entry: Commonwealth Cup

### **17. Seraphinite (IRE)**

A smart winner of a Fillies' Novice at Kempton on her latest start.

Royal Ascot entry: Albany

### **18. Le Don De Vie (GB)**

Winner of both his starts this season most recently on Derby Day at Epsom. A high-class middle distance international racing prospect

### **19. American Lady (IRE)**

An attractive Maiden prospect who caught the eye at Group 3 level last time out.

Royal Ascot entry: Queen Mary Stakes or Windsor Castle Stakes

### **20. Isabeau (IRE)**

Looked a smart filly when winning on her debut on May 31st.

Royal Ascot entry: Queen Mary Stakes or Windsor Castle Stakes

### **21. Red Epaulette (IRE)**

Winner of the opening 2yo race of the Irish season, and placed on both subsequent starts.

Royal Ascot entry: Windsor Castle Stakes

### **22. Maven (USA)**

Winner of his only start at Aqueduct, becoming the first USA winner for his sire American Pharoah.

Royal Ascot entry: Norfolk Stakes

### **23. Pure Zen (FR)**

Almost got up to win the Gr.2 Prix de Sandringham two weeks ago and this Stakes winning filly looks a high class 3-y-o miler
